

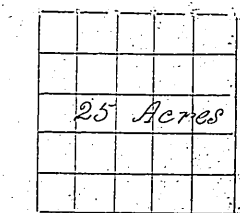

## EWA, OAHU.

**DESCRIPTION.** From the makai end of the stone wall that separates the fish-ponds known as Kakaupohaku and Keilapea run N. 71°10' E. true, 700 feet to the point marked "B" on the chart, said point B being marked by three buried stones marked respectively, A, H & I, the latter sign pointing to true North, and from said point B, the Government Survey signal on Salt Lake Hill bearing S. 67°44' E. true, distant 9393 feet, and running thence along the N. 57°55' E. true (= 48°10' magnetic) 3092 feet to a flat rock marked "HALAWA"; thence N. 60°53' E. true (= 51°43' magnetic) 5190 feet to a peculiarly-pitted stone known as Pohakuaumeume; thence N. 54°38' E. true (= 45°48' magnetic), 4856 feet to hill Poohulua (mark, a Maltese cross cut in the ground); thence along ridge N. 81°12' E. true, 1086 feet to point Kaalanakee similarly marked; thence N. 54°30' E. true, 5330 feet to hill Huiakine, the boundary being the watershed of the ridge skirting the valley of Halawa; thence N. 26°00' E. true, 1880 feet to the hill Uvau, the line following the ridge, and the azimuth and distance from Salt Lake Hill to Uvau being 209°16', 17689 feet; thence down the watershed of ridge skirting valley of Kalawa to point marked "a" on chart, the direct bearing & distance being S. 71°43' W. 8360 feet; thence along Kalawa, S. 56°00' W. true, 11510 feet, to flat rock split thru center, marked "K & A" at S. corner of Capt Meek's land; thence along Dr. J. S. McGrew's lands Paaiiau and Kapuar, S. 30°05' W. true, 1600 feet to a point on the seashore which is N. 32°45' W. 1763 ft. from B, thence along high water mark and fish-pond wall to starting point. Area, 1175 Acres.
